

The beaches - There is a beach near where I am staying called the Alii Kahekili Beach.


The good - Traditional dishes include Bi, a Drick pudding like consistency, kalua pig, like American pulled ports, and of course all the tropical gruit like pineapple,


The priordily people there - The hotel that I am staying at has very friendly staff according to be reviews.
