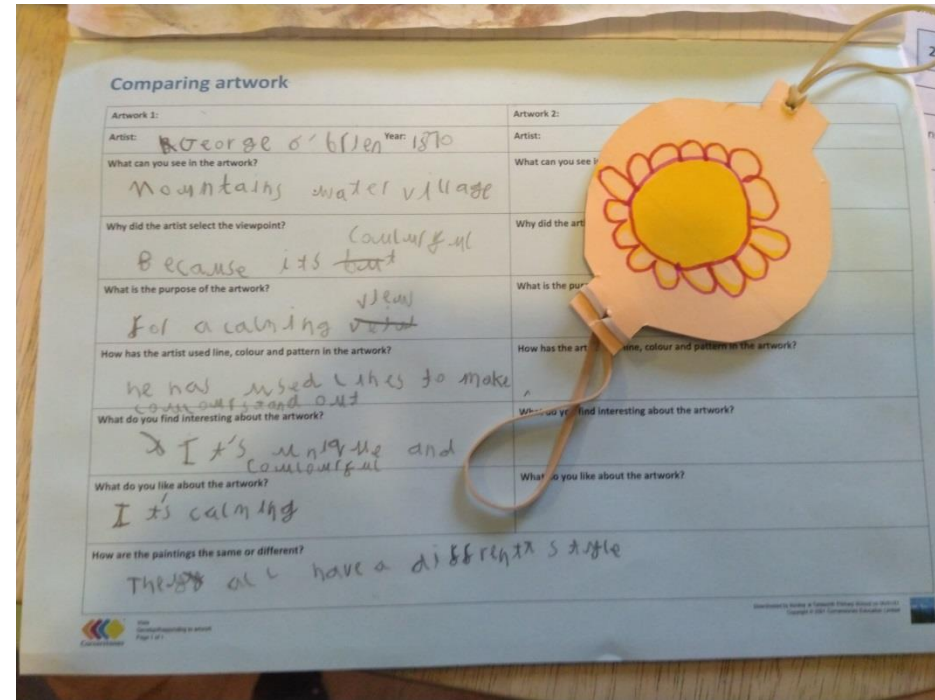
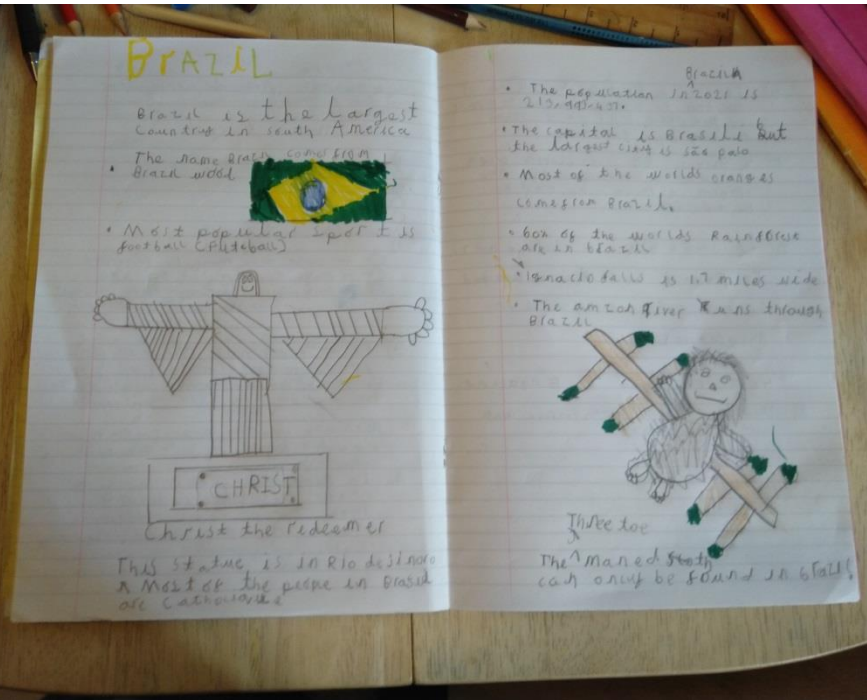


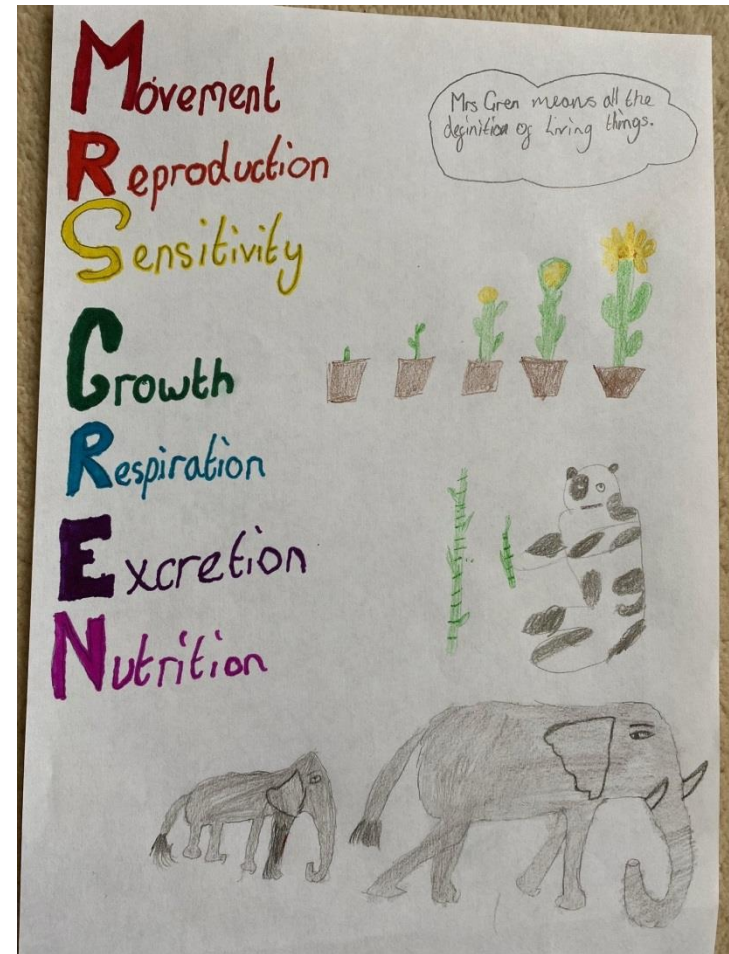
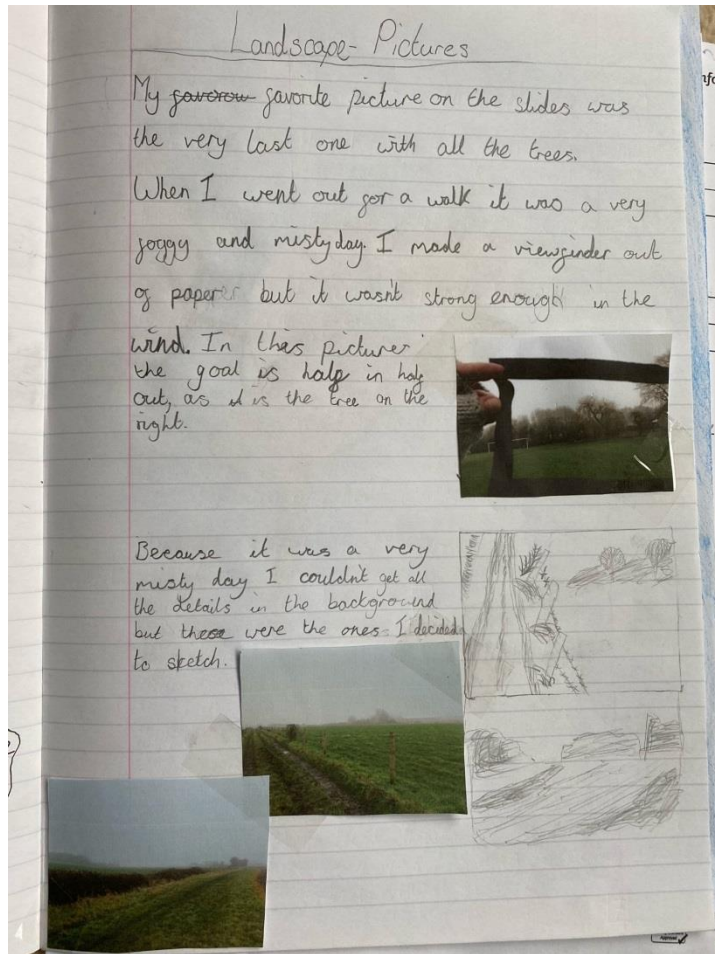
Jasper has been learning about dragons – and made one! He's also been exercising on the bike.



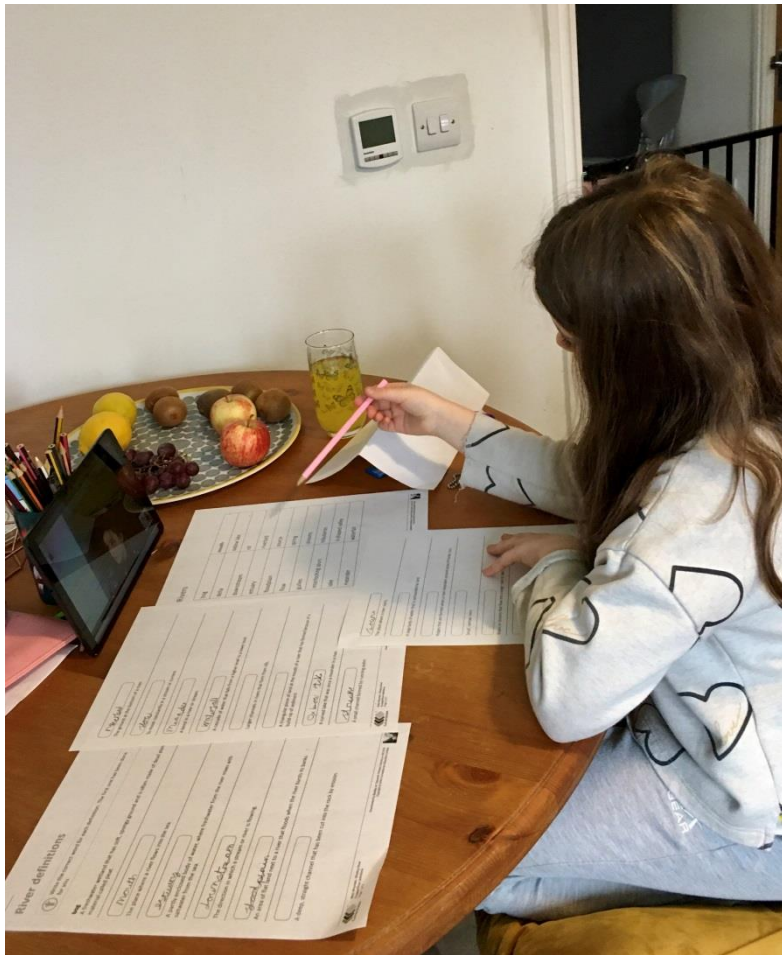
Johnny's Brazil research had some super drawings to go with the facts. He compared landscapes by various artists too.
