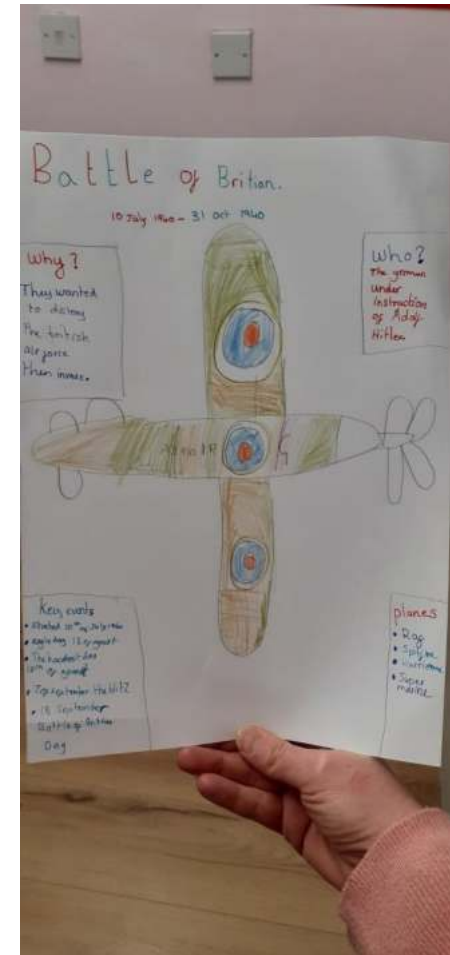
The End
