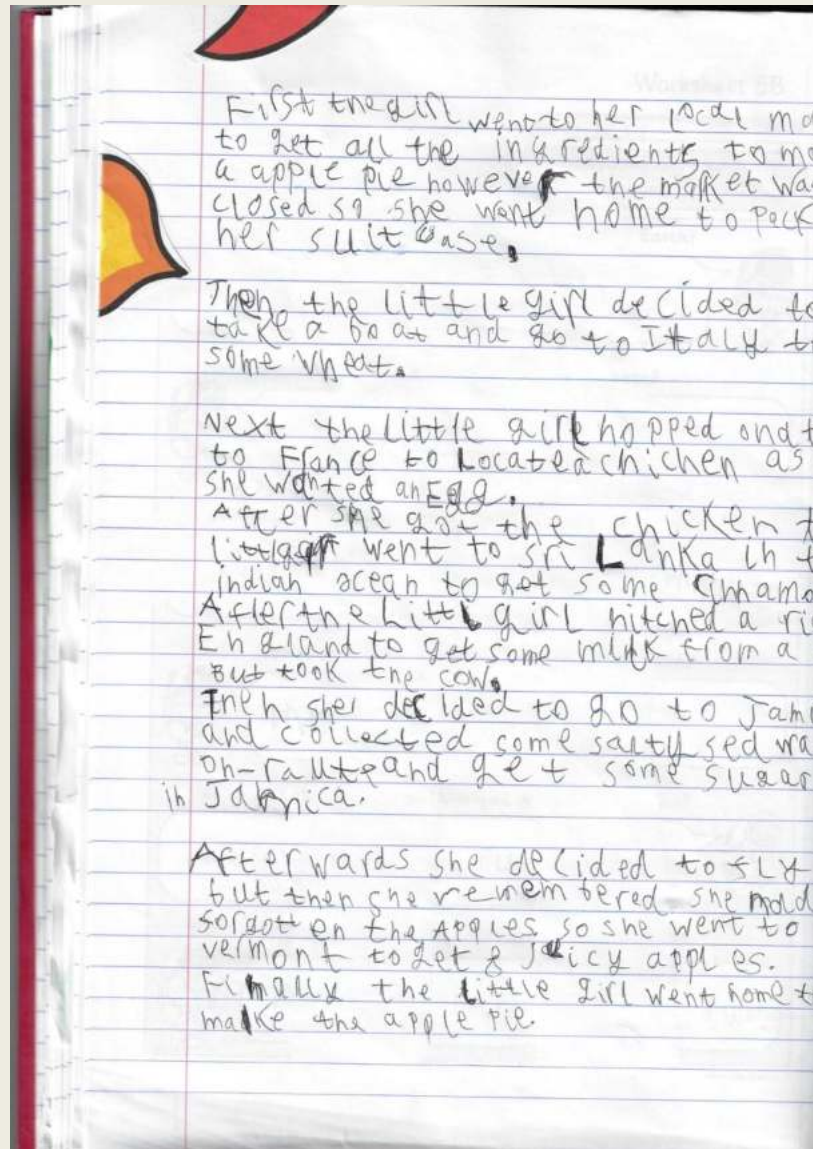


# Class 2 More Intrepid Explorers
