




Class 2 have also done a range of activities to celebrate World Thinking Day. Ryan has designed a new Girl Guide emblem and though about rules that are important to him.

Riley thought about what super power he would like to have and what he would choose if he could have 3 wishes granted.


Riley has also been thinking about rules.
