Vocabulary	
Climate	The average weather conditions over a long period of time.
Equator	An imaginary circle running round the centre of the earth
Humid	Feeling very damp due to water vapour in the air
Species	A group of similar animals or plants
Weather	The specific condition on a given day
Moss	A small flowerless green plant that lacks true roots, growing in damp habitats
Leaf Mould	Rotten leaves
Jungle	An area of land overgrown with dense forest and tangled vegetation
Savannah	A grassy plain in tropical and subtropical regions, with few trees
